

Early Voting for District 9 Election Begins Aug. 21

MONROE, N.C. (August 5, 2019) – One-stop early voting for the September 10, 2019 U.S. Congressional District 9 General Election begins on Wednesday, August 21 and ends on Friday, September 6 at four locations in Union County.

The four early voting sites are the Monroe Library branch (316-A Windsor St.), Wesley Chapel Volunteer Fire Department (315 Waxhaw Indian Trail Rd.), Hemby Bridge Volunteer Fire Department (6628 Mill Grove Rd.) and the Wingate Community Center (315 W. Elm St.).

Union County residents can register to vote and cast a ballot at the early voting site by completing a voter registration form and providing an identifying document showing current address. The identifying document must be a valid North Carolina driver's license, photo ID from a government agency, student ID with a school document showing the student's address, or a utility bill, bank statement, payroll stub or document from any government agency showing name and current address.
